Failing Forward

We have heard the question, "If the possibility of failure were erased, what would you attempt to achieve?" A better question is, "If your perception of and response to failure were changed, what would you attempt to achieve?"

People who fail backwards:

- Blame others
- Repeat mistakes
- Expect to never fail again
- Think they are now a failure
- Quit

People who fail forward:

- Take responsibility for the result
- Learn from mistakes
- Accept failure as part of the process (Something I tried did not work)
- Take new risks
- Persevere

Jesus' predictions of Peter's future

- Horrific failure: **Mark 14:27-31**
- Great success: **Matthew 16:13-19**
- Jesus certainly knew that Peter would deny him when he told Peter that he would be instrumental in the foundation of building Christ's church.
- Sin and/or failure do not disqualify a person from being used mightily by God.

Necessary abilities to fail forward

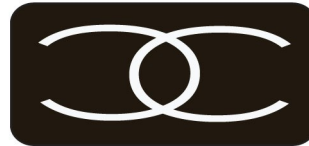
- Ability to reject rejection
- Don't base self-worth on performance
- Never say, "I am a failure." Say instead, "I missed that one," or "I made a mistake,"
- Own your mistakes. Don't blame others or circumstances. Take responsibility, but don't take it personally. **1 John 1:9** – "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
- In 1922 Harry Truman was 38, in debt and out of work. In 1945 he was President of the USA!
- Treat failure as isolated incidents.
- The greater the feat you desire to achieve, the more preparation required to attain the skill and experience necessary.
- You aren't wired to be great at everything.
- Focus on your strengths!
- Strengthen your areas of strength. Develop your skills further.
- Hire a team with multiple strengths, so they can cover each other's weakness. Don't expect everyone to be like you. Hire the opposite of your strengths and value diversity.

The angel from the empty tomb told the women in **Mark 16:7** - "But go, tell His disciples--and Peter--that He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him, as He said to you." It was vital for Peter to know and understand that his sin and failure did not disqualify him from fulfilling the enormous plan that God had for his life.

Like Peter, when we fail, we must fail forward!

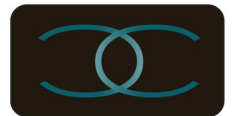
