Primary Text: Mark 1: 4-11

After the season Christmas, Christians all over the world celebrate Epiphany, which signifies the coming of God the Son as a human being in Jesus Christ. The word "epiphany" itself means manifestation or revelation. In the Christian tradition, it is the story of the revelation of God and of God's love in the child born in Bethlehem. The revelation is meant for all people, as symbolized by the arrival of the visitors from far, far away. The theme is clear. There is no limit or boundary to God's love. The whole world, the whole universe and the whole creation is included in that love. The truth is that there are epiphanies of the love of God for all of us. It doesn't matter what our journey of faith happens to be or what pathway we are following. God finds ways of revealing and manifesting His love to us.
