Proverbs 4:5-13

Where to find wisdom

- Older people (elders)
- God's Word
- People with expertise in your area of need or interest
 - Marriage
 - Parenting
 - Money/business
 - Breaking addiction
 - 222
- Wisdom is moving people into proper position in your life
 - There are some people with whom you need to spend more time, with others less!
 - Relationship Target (those closest to the bull's eye have the most influence over your life)

It's a heart thing {Proverbs 4:23}

- Say it, "It's a heart thing."
- NLT—Above all else, guard your heart, for it affects everything you do.
- Genesis 4:6-7, "So, the Lord said to Cain, 'Why are you so angry? And why has your countenance fallen? If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And it's desire is for you, but you should rule over it."
- It's a heart thing.
- Acts 5:3, "But Peter said to Ananias, 'Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit?"
- It is startling to think that Judas' heart was torn away from Jesus, even walking with him daily.
- Satan's entrance to your life is an inside job. The door must be opened from the inside. You must guard your heart.
