

Primary Text: Matthew 9:18-26

When we talk about God we drag a massive amount of expectations and assumptions into the discussion with us about how the world works and what kind of universe we are living in.

When talking about God and the world we often reduce it to an either/or reality: Faith or intellect? Belief or reason? Miracles or logic? God or Science?

How we think about God is directly connected with how we think about the world that we are living in.

What is faith, but openness to possibilities – the belief that something can happen of that something should happen?

We are way too complex,
And so is the world-
Too much surprise,
Too many possibilities,
Too much that defies or limited logical categories – to fit everything through the narrow filter of reason alone.

There is a problem with decisively dismissing all miracles out of hand because strange things do happen, things with no precedent and n explanation, every single day and every single moment, billions and billions of times a second, all around us.
