## **Dig Deeper**

- A certain man (every man; describes the human condition)
  - Fell among thieves (world, flesh & devil) John 10:10
  - Stripped him of his clothing (lost righteousness) Isaiah 61:10
  - Wounded—physically, emotionally, mentally, relationally & financially
  - ♦ Half Dead—alive physically but dead spiritually John 3:1-7 -
  - ♦ Certain priest—dead, dry lifeless-religion can't help you
  - Levite—set apart for Temple service, teachers of the Law
    Religion without compassion is helpless and hopeless.
    Legalism destroys joy and hope.
    - O Legalism destroys joy and take Consortion
- Certain Samaritan
  - God uses ordinary, even objectionable people (David, Peter, Paul, Rahab)
  - A person does not have to possess special talents or gifts to chow compassion.
- Jesus is the true Good Samaritan!
  - Luke 15:20—Prodigal Son
  - Matthew 14:14—Multitude
  - Mark 1:40-41—Leper
  - Bandaged wounds—Jesus is concerned with your whole life, not just your spiritual life.
  - ♦ Pouring on oil and wine—Holy Spirit
  - Own animal
  - *"Inn"* = the Church
  - Two days wages
