## **Giving Credit Where Credit is Due**

Luke 17:11-18 Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. 12 As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance 13 and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" 14 When [Jesus] saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed. 15 One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. 16 He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him— and he was a Samaritan. 17 Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? 18 Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?"

## **3 WAYS WE GIVE CREDIT WHERE CREDIT IS DUE**

1. ACKNOWLEDGE EVERY GOOD THING I HAVE COMES FROM GOD.

## 2. LEARN THE SECRET OF BEING CONTENT

Ecclesiastes 6:9 Better what the eye sees than the roving of the appetite....

Philippians 4:11-13...For I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. 12 I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. <u>I have learned the secret of being content</u> in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. 13 I can do all this through [Christ] who gives me strength.

## 3. TURN EVERY BLESSING I HAVE INTO PRAISE.

Psalm 63:4-5 I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.5 I will be fully satisfied as with the richest of foods; with singing lips my mouth will praise you.

Psalm 103:2-5 NLT Let all that I am praise the Lord; may I never forget the good things he does for me. 3 He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. 4 He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies. 5 He fills my life with good things....
