Galatians 3:7-9

There is an attitude of faith.

- Praise is the attitude of faith.
- Fear, worry, anxiety, hopelessness are attitudes of doubt.
- Faith praises when the natural circumstances suggest crying
- Faith shouts the victory when defeat surrounds.
- Faith dances, waves arms and sings in the midst of pandemonium
- Faith has no care, with eyes fixed upon the Word of God.
- The feet of faith are standing on the promises, which shall never fail.
- Faith is losing ones natural mind, replacing it with the mind of Christ.
- Praising and thanking God in the middle of the storm expresses great confidence in the delivering, healing, strengthening hand of God.
