Divinely Timed Universe

 - Being consistently late for appointments and work

- Wisdom implies that we all must confront our own death. There is a rhythm to life.
 - Psalm 90:2 So teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.
 - Ephesians 5:16 Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days.
- Divine Determination—everything is pre-determined by God?

 - Does God prearrange the entire universe to just do something in my life?
 - Many aspects of life are under our direct control!

- Natural cycles of nature, life and society
 - Life is made of seasons and opportunities
 - Actions & reactions must be appropriate to the relationship or circumstance
